- Live Work Practice Across Europe France, Italy, Germany, Portugal, Romania, Poland, Argentina, Turkey, Hungary, Slovenia, Norway.
- Examples date back over 80 years.
- Active development, Transmission 50's, Distribution 80's
- Examples of activity levels.
- Professionalism
- Centralised industry control (Country Live Work Committees)
- Representatives: Transmission, Distribution, Trainers, R&D and Safety.
- Training Providers



ICOLIM - Strasbourg April 2017

- Safety and Employment Regulations.
- Live Work Committees (LWC) have responsibility for Regulations, Defining Work Methods, Approving Training Providers, Setting Competence Standards, Equipment Approval, Analysis of all Accidents.
- Training Provider approval and quality management.
- Changing network environment and function (Passive to Active).
- Customer service focus, key network justification also needed to embrace new technologies.
- Reported SAIDI - 17 minutes France; 3 minutes Elect Strasbourg
- Increasing training demand.

- Maintaining Competency - Example: 50 days stick and glove each year, Exam + 4 days monitoring.
- R&D tools and equipment.
- Work planning.
- Safety performance past 5 years France.
