The water was confirmed to be a domestic water leak.

#### WHAT COULD HAVE HAPPENED?

If things had gone differently the Team member could have sustained an injury with long term consequences.

#### WHAT ARE WE DOING?

Investigating water losses from pressure systems and identifying and fixing any further water leaks.

## **YOUR INPUT & ACTION REQUIRED**

- Watch where you are walking
- Look for any ground deformation
  - Flag it immediately to
    Operations for investigation
  - Put hazard barriers in place to prevent access and potential injury
